HEATING AND HOT WATER

Depending on the time of year the heating should be on, but if it is cold the thermostat is at the top of the stairs behind the chest of drawers, and the timer is in the airing cupboard.

Always check that the hot water is on. If there is not enough hot water the timer is in the airing cupboard. Either boost the water control for an extra hour or move to the constant position.

THE AGA (in addition to the aga there is an electric hob.)

The aga will be at a temperature that will be appropriate for your cooking needs. However if that is not the case, the following will help you understand the aga and if necessary increase the temperature.

The dial on the front is defunct and does nothing to change the temperature of the aga. The aga works on stored heat, so the more the front doors are opened or the lids up, for boiling water or frying, the more heat is lost and the aga will then take time to heat up again. The four ovens vary in temperature. Top right is for roasting, bottom right for baking, top left for simmering and the bottom left is the coolest and is for warming.

With regards to the tops, the left hand one is the hottest.

Toast is cooked on the aga top using the metal circular sandwich rack.

To the left of the aga inside the kitchen cupboard is a device that controls the temperature, but it should be noted that this does not provide instant heat. With the dial positioned in the '1 o'clock' the aga will be running at optimal cooking temperature. At a '5 o'clock' position the oven will only be warm.
